1. The PEDiaT Approach

 - The psycho-educational understanding of five main learning disorders
 - How the standard operating procedure in diagnosing a specific disorder is carried out.
 - ★ Level 2—General PEDiaT Practitioner's Certificate II
 - The different types of psycho-educational assessment
 - How to do a psycho-educational analysis of results obtained from criterion-/norm-referenced assessments
 - ★ Level 3—Registered PEDiaT Practitioner's Certificate A
 - An extension of the previous level
 - The differential diagnosis of learning disorders and their co-morbidities
 - ★ Level 4—Registered PEDiaT Practitioner's Certificate B
 - Focuses on drawing an appropriate treatment program (IEP)
 - How to implement IEP
 - ★ Level 5—Certified PEDiaT Practitioner's Certificate
 - The model of collaborative consultation
